



HELP THE ARCTIC FOX - DO NOT FEED THE RED FOX

- ❁ Anyone can help protect the Arctic fox by properly disposing of food waste that attracts red foxes. The red fox is the Arctic fox's main competitor. The overpopulation of red foxes can be controlled by minimizing food scraps and game waste left behind by humans in the wilderness.
- ❁ Take with you only as much food as you need and check in advance if there is an opportunity for composting food waste along your route. Do not leave food scraps in the wilderness. If you cannot take them with you, bury the scraps in the ground or under stones.
- ❁ Fishing and hunting waste or bycatch should not be left in the wilderness, as it attracts Red foxes. Be prepared to either take the game waste back to your accommodation or bury it in the ground or under stones so that red foxes cannot detect it.
